Program Briefs Portfolio

A concise guide to the information HRVG uses to define, assess, approve, and communicate proposed programs.

- **Rights and protection**

Initiatives may address dignity, access to services, safeguarding, protection, civic inclusion, and the rights of vulnerable or underserved populations.

- **Education and capacity**

HRVG may collaborate on inclusive education, professional learning, institutional capacity building, community awareness, and multidisciplinary knowledge exchange.

- **Health and community wellbeing**

Partnership concepts may support prevention, referral pathways, community education, psychosocial wellbeing, and coordinated services, subject to qualified leadership and local requirements.

- **Program approval standard**

Every program brief should state the need, participants, location, partners, activities, results, indicators, budget assumptions, safeguarding measures, risks, sustainability plan, and responsible approvals.

Individual program briefs become official only after technical review, budget validation, partner confirmation, and written authorization.
