Standards for credible, ethical, accessible, and decision-relevant HRVG research and knowledge products.

- **Publication types**

Policy briefs, situational analyses, baseline studies, evidence reviews, technical notes, learning briefs, conference materials, and research reports.

- **Research integrity**

Each publication should identify authorship, affiliations, methods, sources, limitations, funding, conflicts of interest, ethical review requirements, and the date and version of release.

- **Human-participant protection**

Research involving people should use informed consent, privacy safeguards, secure data handling, risk minimization, and appropriate ethics or institutional review.

- **Quality and accessibility**

Claims should be proportionate to evidence. Peer review must be described accurately, corrections should be transparent, and public products should use clear language and accessible formats.

Only completed, authorized publications should appear as HRVG research. Drafts, concepts, and unreviewed materials must be clearly labeled.
